Reading records

Your child's reading record is a brilliant way for you to record everything you read with your child at home. They will be checked every week so we can see how they have been getting on! Please try and read as much as you can at home - ideally every night!

Most children will come home with one book that is in line with their phonics knowledge (RWI book bag book) and also one school book. The phonics reading book is one that they should be encouraged to read to you with their phonics knowledge from school. The school book will involve you reading the book together. In addition to these 2 books, the children will also bring home a book that they have picked from the library. This will give you the opportunity to share a book together that they have shown an interest in and in turn develop their love of reading.
